Students

The school community expects that you will.....

1. Bring the school diary and text books according to the time-table Daily. Other books or magazines shall not be brought to the class.
2. Attend the school regularly.
3. Do not bring any sharp instruments to school.
4. Treat others with kindness, courtesy and respect including classmates , teachers, staff and visitors.
5. Maintain honesty and integrity in all academic work.
6. Use technology responsibly and in accordance with school policies, including guidelines on internet use, social media and electronic devices.
7. Respect school property and facilities, avoiding vandalism or damage.
8. Behave in a manner that promotes a positive learning environment, avoiding disruptive or disrespectful behaviour.
9. Look after your own property (stuff).

PARENTS

The school expects that you will:

1. Ensure that your child comes properly attired to school (ironed and washed clothes, polished shoes and proper hair).
2. Be available if it is necessary, to discuss aspects of your child's behaviour at school.

3. Insist on your child's regular attendance and punctuality.
4. Sign messages, progress report and other similar documents when requested to do so.
5. Check the parent teacher link book daily and ensure that the assignments mentioned are done by the child himself/herself.
6. Counter sign remarks made in the diary.
7. Ensure that your child is not absent on the first or last day of the school term without prior permission and that any leave taken from school is duly sanctioned in advance.
8. Contact an individual class teacher during his/her free periods by taking prior appointments through the diary from the teacher /coordinator/principal to discuss a matter of concern about your child.
9. Inform the school about your child's absence in advance.
10. Speak respectfully about teachers, especially in the presence of your child.
11. Exert firm parental discipline in cases where your child's behaviour is distracting from the quality of learning opportunities for others in the school.
12. Keep your child at home if he is suffering from any contagious diseases like mumps, measles, chicken pox, smallpox, whooping cough, conjunctivitis and send him to school with the doctor's fitness certificate.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR SCHOOL BUSES

1. Students must maintain discipline at all times while travelling to and fro from school
2. Students should always be punctual at the pick-up points, They should also board the bus soon after dispersal time.

3. A change of pick-up or drop point will only be allowed after permission is given by the school authorities.
4. It is for the safety of the children that they must remain seated in the bus and not put their head or hands outside the window.
5. Senior students are expected to care for the younger ones, while the younger ones should respect their seniors.
6. Students are expected to take care of properties of the buses, such as seat cover, window parts, mats etc. Damage to the above properties is liable for a fine.

A TRUE BFISIAN

1. Every student must have his/her student hand book (diary), whenever asked.
2. Respecting parents, teachers & all elders is expected from every student.
3. Seeking permission from teachers while entering other classes is mandatory.
4. Uniform is the mirror of school's glory so keeping it neat, tidy and properly worn is the humble duty of every student. Only two plats (चोटी) for girls is allowed (I to X) for XI and XII one plat.
5. The style of talking to senior students, colleagues and junior students is a part of what you have learnt in school, so it must be proper and admirable by all.
6. Creating a friendly & conducive environment on the school premises and being friends with each other is a basic moral value and every BFISIAN must inculcate it.
7. Your behaviour in the school bus is a representation of your character so it must be very gentle.
8. Taking care of the school property like chairs, tables, window panes, sports goods, band instruments etc. is expected from every student.

9. Keeping the school premises neat & clean is the duty of every student, and cleanliness should come from within.
10. No student is expected to carry along any money with him/her to the school.
11. The student is forbidden to bring cell phones, cameras , smart watches or any other electronic gadgets to school. Incase failing adhere to the school rules, the gadgets will be confiscated.
12. No students are allowed to bring vehicles inside periphery of the school.

Admission and Withdrawal

1. The Management reserves the right to refuse admission to any student without furnishing any reasons.
2. For withdrawal of a pupil from the School, at least one calendar months' notice must be given in writing, otherwise one calendar month's fee in lieu of notice will be charged.
3. The school reserves the right to dismiss a student who is irregular in attendance, whose conduct in the school as well as outside the school is harmful to other students and whose parents/guardians show little interest in their wards as well as in the school affairs. Immorality, insubordination, discourtesy, disrespect to teachers, contempt of authority or willful damage to property results in the immediate dismissal of the student from the school.
4. The name of a pupil who remains absent without leave for TWO school weeks shall be struck off the rolls.

1. The last day to deposit the fee will be the 10th of every month, failing which:
 - Late fee of Rs 20 per day will be charged
2. If the fee is not deposited after 60 days, the name of the student is liable to be struck off & re-admission will be granted subject to availability of a seat & on deposit of the re-admission fee.
3. The fee for the month of June will be paid in the month of May & for the month of March, the fee is supposed to be paid in the month of February.

1. Students are prepared for the Central Board of Secondary Education for Classes 10 and 12.
2. A child should secure a minimum passing grade of 'D' in each subject in the aggregate. Results declared at the end of the year will be final and will not be reconsidered. The Principal's decision is final.
3. At least 75% attendance is compulsory for promotion as per CBSE by Laws .
4. Exemption from an evaluation will be given to student only under exceptional circumstances and at the discretion of the Principal. In such cases, his final result/promotion will depend on the grades obtained in the other evaluation procedures of the same subjects as well as his year's work.
5. Only those students who have paid the complete school fees will be permitted to appear for the final exams.
6. Willful breach of any of the regulations pertaining to the conduct of the examination can lead to expulsion from the examination. The paper of the student caught using or assisting in the use of unfair means in the exams, will be declared null or void.
7. Students with special needs are provided with every facility as per the CBSE rules and regulations.
8. Exams are taken as per CBSE guidelines:
 - **PA 1** – tentatively in May/July
 - Half Yearly – tentatively in September / October
 - **PA 2** - tentatively in December / January
 - **Finals** - tentatively in February / March)For Classes 10 and 12, pre board 2 in February) Preboard I first in December, Preboard 2 in February

(Guidelines for Parents and Students for admission to foreign universities)

1. Students seeking admission in Foreign Universities need to apply for the following documents well in time (at least one month prior to the last date of submission)
 - a) LOR from the Counsellor
 - b) Subject recommendation from the teacher concerned in each subject.
 - c) Transcripts
2. Projected score will be based on
 - a) Final mark sheet of class XI
 - b) Mid Term report of Class XII
3. Grades in the certificates will be strictly on the basis of assessment and merit.
4. Only in the event of student missing an exam because he is representing the school, a retest will be given.
5. Projected score will be strictly as per performance in the exams.
6. A CV and a photocopy of all the supporting certificates must be attached with the application.

At least 5 working days are required to upload the information on the portals of the concerned university/ies after completion of drafting and typing of the LOR's.

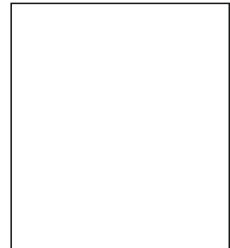
